- School Improvements The kindergarten playground is underway. The concrete pathways
 alongside the demountables will be done on first day of school holidays as well as some tree
 lopping. A new audio screen has been installed in the hall.
- **Sustainability Grant** We were successful in getting a grant for just under \$3000 to rejuvenate the kitchen garden and also get a pump for our water tank.
- **Department of Veteran Affairs Grant** of \$4000 for the ANZAC garden. The mural, garden and silhouette of the unknown soldier to be completed in next 3 weeks. Our ANZAC service will be held on the first day back of Term 2 and Currans Hill will again march in the Camden Street Parade on the 25th April.
